



# SWIM-MASTER

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## United States Masters Swimming

As we enter the new year, questions concerning the registration of athletes, clubs, sanctions and insurance continue to be raised. Stated as simply as possible, the authority to administer the Masters Swimming program is legally vested in the Masters Swimming Committee. Neither the National AAU nor the local AAU associations have any jurisdiction over Masters Swimming. Likewise, neither US Aquatic Sports Inc. (USAS) nor US Swimming Inc. (USS) have any control over our program. This is not to say that we will not work with them and through them to the mutual needs and benefits of our programs as those occasions arise. (We have contracted with National AAU for registration and limited financial services and have letters of agreement with USS and Penn Mutual-AAU Masters Sports.)

At this point, I would like to define the aquatic structure as I presently understand it. USAS is a corporation made up to meet the international (FINA) requirement of a single aquatics body to represent the four disciplines and USAS is composed of these four corporations: US Swimming, US Diving, US Water Polo and US Synchronized Swimming. Master Diving, Masters Water Polo and Masters Synchronized Swimming are integrated committees of the above corporations; Masters Swimming is NOT a committee of US Swimming, but a separate corporate entity.

As a national corporate entity, final authority for Masters Swimming rests with your Board of Governors who are elected or appointed to serve in this capacity. It is they who elect your officers and zone chairmen, amend the code, by-laws and rules, act upon recommendations presented to them and decisions made by the Board of Directors and officers between meetings of the Board of Governors.

The authority passes from the Board of Governors through the officers to the Local Masters Swimming Committee (LMSC) to operate and regulate our sport at the local level. I have asked the delegate(s) to the Board of Governors from each geographic area to form a LMSC to administer our sport at the local level. (For the present, we have used the AAU zone, region and association

boundaries rather than try to redevine our own.) Each LMSC is to be composed of at least one elected or appointed person to conduct the operation, registration and liaison between the local swimmers and clubs and the local AAU and the National Masters Committee. Where possible, the LMSC should have a president, secretary-treasurer and registration chairman to fill these functions.

Among its duties, the LMSC is to set local fees for registration, club membership and sanctions; also to oversee the meet schedule, rules enforcement, officiating, local records, discipline -- in short, everything the local AAU had the authority to do. Because this is a transition year, and because your Board of Governors has contracted with the National AAU for athlete registration for 1981, the total registration program can best be implemented if the LMSC's will contract with the local AAU's for this service.

Your Board of Governors set a national registration fee of \$2.75 per registered swimmer, which includes 75¢ mandatory athlete's accident insurance fee. The LMSC is to add to this amount what is needed to cover the fee negotiated with the local AAU for registration, the mandatory general liability insurance, other services such as office expense and whatever amount the LMSC needs for its operation. (The National AAU office has indicated that the mandatory liability insurance will amount to about 50¢ per registration. Whether you raise this fee through your registrations, club fees, sanction fees or meet proceeds, keep in mind that the total cost will come to about 50¢ per swimmer registered during 1981. Estimated bills will be rendered over the current year based on 1980 registrations and then adjusted for actual 1981 registrations at a later date.)

A \$10.00 club fee was established at the National level. Each club registering will receive a Rules book (single copies of the 1981 book are \$4.50 from the Order Department of AAU House, 3400 West 86th St., Indpls., IN 46268). A Club must be registered for its swimmers and relays to participate in the National meets and to be considered for Top Ten Times. The fee and request for registration is to be sent to Adrienne Pipes, 1214 Nolan Ave., Chula Vista, CA 92011.

The LMSC may also charge a club registration fee and clubs that wish to be represented on the Board of Managers of the local AAU would be subject to the AAU fee for that affiliation.

Every effort should be made to negotiate a contract covering the registration and general liability insurance aspects with the local AAU. Please keep in mind that if a LMSC cannot negotiate a contract with a local AAU, then the LMSC will have to handle the registration function with the National AAU office. This will involve a fee of \$1.00 to National and will entail monthly reporting to them, collecting and remitting the registration and insurance fees, and processing registration cards, sanctions and certificates of insurance. Also remember a valid sanction must be issued for the general liability insurance to be in force at a swim meet.

Every effort should be made to be sure that each LMSC is viable and prepared to handle the registration function, since this task may fall to us at some future date. I regret that misunderstandings between the LMSC's and local AAU's will persist. The old line of authority from National AAU to its sports committees and local associations does not dissipate easily. If there are conflicts, please do not hesitate to contact any of your officers or have the local AAU office contact me.

I am asking each of you to send me a short report as to the status of your LMSC along with the names, addressees and phone numbers of its officers. A copy should be sent to Adrienne also.

On February 26, 1981, the Masters Swimming Committee of the A.A.U., Inc. received exemption from Federal income taxes under section 501 (c) (3) from the District Director of the IRS in Cincinnati, Ohio. Of equal importance is that under our foundation status classification 509 (a) (2) as an organization formed to promote amateur sports competition at the national and international level, volunteers may deduct on their income tax returns expenses incurred in support of the Corporation and may also deduct contributions to the Corporation.

The next step will be to file for a change of the Corporate name to "UNITED STATES MASTERS SWIMMING, Inc." as voted at the Annual Meeting in Snowbird last October.

It appears that one of the services the Masters Swimming Committee of the A.A.U. Inc. can offer its LMSC's is tax exemption by filing an annual letter with the IRS indicating those LMSC's which can be included under our "group exemption". One general observation would be that if the LMSC

handles more than \$10,000 yearly, it should be separately incorporated, though this is not mandatory.

Total registration reported by the A.A.U. for 1980 was 7022. I suspect this number to be low because of incorrect reporting. Again I emphasize the importance of the letters MS in the upper right-hand corner block of the registration applications, which designates the sports code for Masters Swimming to those who do the computer input for AAU.

On March 27 & 28, chairmen of 12 masters sports programs met with representatives of the Penn Mutual Life Ins. Co. in Philadelphia. Sports represented were archer, cycling, diving, long distance running, long distance swimming, powerlifting, rowing, synchro-swimming, swimming, track & field, weightlifting and wrestling. A proposal was made for the presentation of a National Masters Sports Festival to be held in Philadelphia, August 13-16, 1982.

Jack Kelly and Jon Buzzard were appointed as administrative co-chairmen for the event. Each sports committee would be responsible for staging their event(s) similar to producing a National Championship meet. Each Masters committee has the responsibility of providing the contestants, and the officials to conduct the events in an organized and professional manner.

The purpose of the "festival" is to present to the general adult public the wide spectrum of competitive sports open to them and the wide range of ages and abilities of the contestants. Media coverage of a scope unavailable to any single Masters sport is expected to promote our Masters sports on a scale never before possible.

Whereas I like the overall concept of a masters sports festival, it will entail for us the equivalent amount of work of putting on a national meet. It is my thought that this meet might be delegated to the Zone A LMSC's to sponsor and operate. I suggest that it be a short course meet with the 1650 omitted from the program. Those wishing to swim longer distances would be able to do so under the Long Distance Swimming Committee's portion of the program. A short course meet would allow us to use 2-25 yard courses in a 50 meter pool which should help to shorten the time needed to run the events. It is certain that some swimmers will want to participate in other sports of the festival. Most important is that I do not want to have a Long Course meet of this potential magnitude going on here in the East just two weeks prior to our National Long Course in Portland, OR. This meet would therefore be a 1983 Top Ten meet.

# A Whisker of Pride

**G**ROWING UP is a discarding of dreams—the not-to-be triumphs, the too-dizzying heights, the still-distant horizons. They come in the golden rush of childhood, but they cannot stay. They won't telescope down to the ordinary strictures of time laid out for the chores that need doing.

Yet sometimes, in the long years of burdens, there's a madcap, will-o'-the-wisp moment when—like a child—we can grab at a sparkle in the sky. Reach high for such moments; don't let them pass. For once they are gone they may not come again, and we will have missed a brightness.

All last summer I waited for such a chance, a tiny dream teasing in my mind. Finally it came.

A mile and a half across from our vacation place on Parry Island in Ontario's Georgian Bay lies Palestine Island, a long, dark slope of rock slabs and pine trees. In the evening the sun sets beyond Palestine in a running fire of gold and rose, and then, through a crook in the trees, the distant Carling Rock Lighthouse shines down the night like a blue star.

On a Palestine cliff in a straight line across from our beach is a white house, looking small as a cardboard toy, surrounded by shadows. Only rarely does some unseen hand light a lamp so the windows gleam as if a spark of sun had caught in the glass. I had been watching that house over the years; now, suddenly, a desire arose in me—without rhyme or reason, utterly inappropriate—to swim the dark waters to its isolation.

But of course it was ridiculous. I am a grandmother. I have five children. In the world's eye I have done nothing all these years but housework, and we all know *that* is not conducive to the body beautiful. Although I had come to love swimming, and each summer vacation

tried painfully to teach myself the art, it really hadn't worked. Once, when someone told me I was swimming in 20 feet of water, I almost drowned from sudden hysteria.

But that tiny dream kept buzzing through my thoughts. So I began to practice regularly—until "Mother's daily dip" became a family joke. I never missed a day, even in storms, sometimes emerging almost strangled from the banging waves. All the time I was waiting—waiting for strength, for confidence, for a calm day not too cold, and for a scarcity of folks to argue me out of it.

The summer passed without those conditions. Wistfully, I gave up the dream, telling myself I was really too old anyway. Then, late on the last afternoon of vacation, when I was standing on the shore looking out over the water toward the distant, brooding house, the moment came.

The bay was empty of boats since most of the cottagers had already departed. All my family had left, too, save my youngest son. When I dipped my foot in the water, I was surprised it was no colder. The wind of the last two days had died, and the waves were rolling in, easy and gentle. Across the bay the sinking sun was laying a path of gold to my feet, inviting me, urging me, and suddenly, in a lonely calmness, I knew this was my chance into the unknown of what I could do.

I ran back to the cabin where my son was practicing his guitar and rapped on the window.

"I'm swimming to Palestine," I said.

A chord broke off in midair. "Are you crazy?"

"No, serious. Get the canoe, life-jackets, a coat and towel. I've got to hurry. There's only about an hour of daylight left."

I whirled back to the shore and eased into the gold path of sunlight. I swam carefully, testing myself. My muscles felt supple and sure and I breathed easier.

The sun was skidding into the horizon, dimming my path, when my son, bewildered, paddled up and asked if I was all right.

"Fine," I said, meaning my head included, and swam on, at intervals varying my strokes from breast to back to left and right side.

The darkening distance ahead seemed to stretch implacably, and then the sun went down completely and my path disappeared in the black waters. I had not realized how the cold of the deeper water would

eat into my marrow. A layer of numbness ringed my body, and doubts began to arise. *Could* I finish? Should I keep trying? Was I being foolish?

My son asked me urgently, "Are you cold?"

"No!" A firm lie.

"Are you tired?"

"No!" Another lie.

"Don't you want to turn back?"

"No!" The truth this time.

I swam on, counting strokes, watching for my son's paddle when he pointed it, showing how I was off course. Then I would straighten my line, doggedly trying not to cough or choke, though once a spray of unexpected wake caught me wrong. I no longer looked toward the white house. It stayed too far away, fading into a glimmer shrouded by night.

On and on, and then a little roughness of water and I realized I was in the main channel. I almost laughed. I must be getting there. Overhead the stars were coming out and I watched a scrap of twinkling as though it were a bird leading me on.

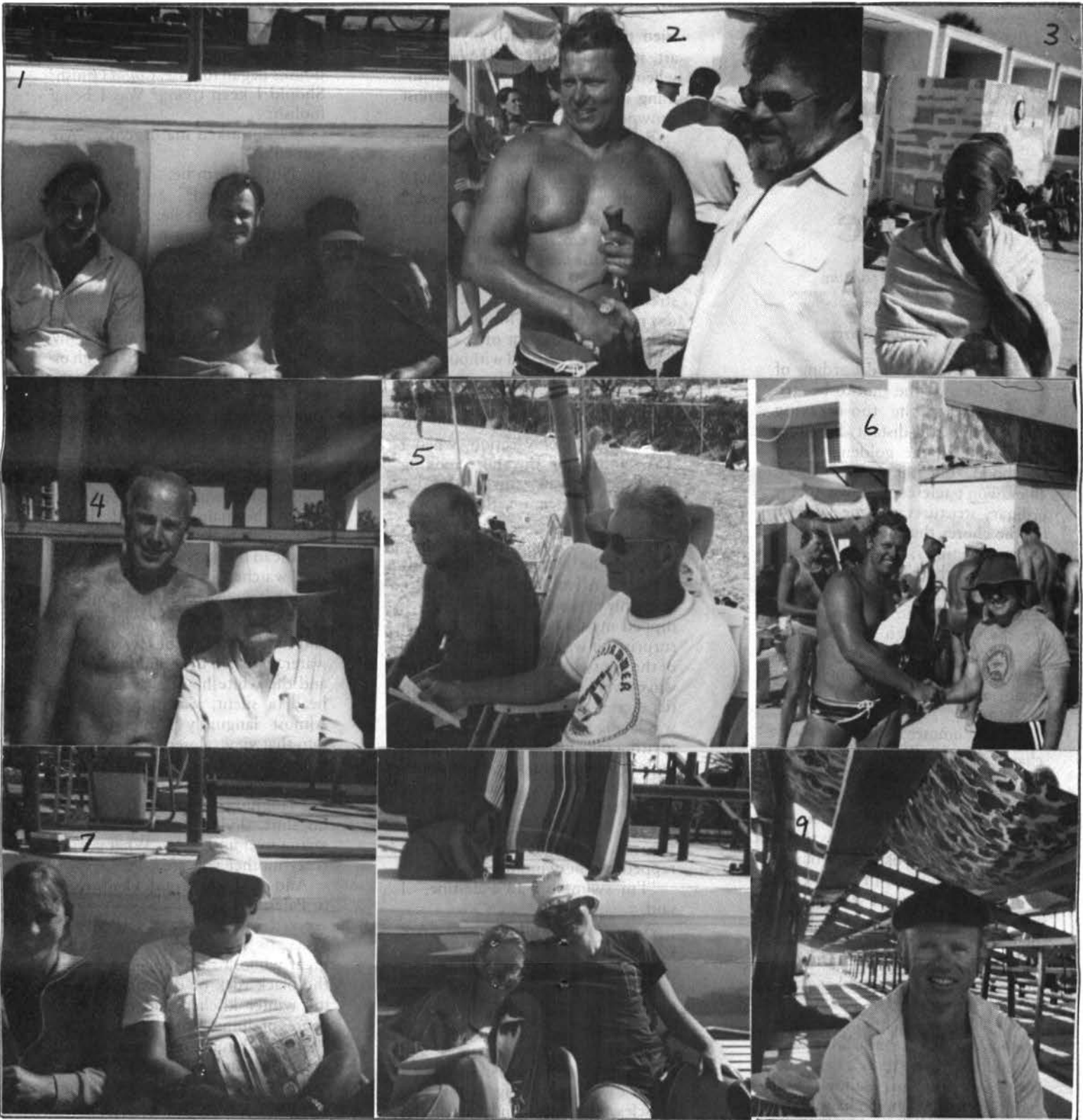
Another hundred backstrokes and suddenly I slid into warm, quiet water. I turned over and looked up, and the white house was above my head, a silent, watching presence. Almost languidly I breaststroked into that view, closer and closer. My foot felt the hard cliff shelving under the water and I stood up, and my son was laughing, wrapping my head in his shirt, drying me with a towel, saying over and over, "What a wild, crazy mother you are."

And oh! I was proud. I had swum to Palestine!

WELL, OF COURSE, the world with a great whoosh flip-flopped me from the black rock of Palestine back to my winter kitchen and my winter chores of dinner by the clock, proper clothes with functioning zippers and accurate laundering. And that moment of shining pride faded and dwindled until only a whisker remained. And one morning, doing dishes, I wondered if I would forget entirely.

Then, through the window, I saw on my lawn a cobweb from the night—an old lady's cap, we used to call it. And dew hung on it—sparkling drops laced in sunlight like jewels... like jewels dropped from a wind off... off Palestine, of course! I smiled in my mind, for I knew then there would be no forgetting. That whisker of pride was mine forever.

**RENEWALS** - Check the code number on your label to determine your last issue. The first number designates the last issue that you will receive in the year designated by the last two numbers. Also, your label will be stamped with a red Time to Renew on your last issue. Third class mail is not forwarded! Nor is it returned. If you move, please send notification.....

**NATIONAL RECORD SETTERS** - No record will be accepted by the national records chairman UNLESS a duplicate time card is sent signed by each of the three timers (button pusher and timer when electronic timing is used). It is the responsibility of each swimmer who thinks his time may be a record time to get a duplicate card and have it signed by the timers. No other person can assume this responsibility. Some of next year's Top Ten Times are going to be faster than the record - because the time card was not submitted by the swimmer.....

**BEER AND SWIMMING IN COLOGNE, GERMANY** - New England Masters International correspondent Nick Fazzano reports: Approximately 30 American swimmers and their friends journeyed to Germany in March to take part in the 8th Annual International Masters Meet commemorating the 50th Anniversary of the founding of the Hurth Swim Club located on the outskirts of Cologne. Friday's night's distance events were swum in the old recreation pool and after 3 hours of competition, we proceeded down the street to the nearest beer hall. The Germans take their entertainment seriously and had safely scheduled Saturday's events to begin at three in the afternoon. What a surprise to see them pull out their cigarettes after a few beers! Saturday we swam in the new athletic center pool. Friday's events attracted only 100 participants but for Sat. there were easily 400. No event on Sat. was longer than 50 mts. After five hours of sprints, we proceeded back to the beer hall for the award ceremony and some comments by the Mayor. Since the Germans feel that anything more than 50 mts is a long distance race, and since they make very good beer, Saturday night's festivities ran well into Sunday morning. Before the last day's events were over, the meet was stopped and all the American swimmers were asked to assemble at one end of the pool. The Mayor arrived and we were unexpectedly presented with a momento of the Meet, a plate showing a picture of the oldest building in the town. This reporter was amazed and embarrassed at the hospitality shown by the Hurth Swim Club. Many, many people went out of their way to see that our stay in Germany was enjoyable, friendly and comfortable. I hope that we will remember to do the same for our foreign guests at future National meets.....
