Meeting Notes:

1) Minutes from 3/8/12 were approved.

- Some feedback mechanism should be made available for members who have suggested changes.

- Chris to share current LMSC draft templates with compiled feedback with BOD and LMSC Development Committee.

3) Discuss how to promote and recruit volunteers for positions

- Chris copied VRTF on email response to Rob B. note on 4/5

- Options to use free services or bulletin boards to allow members to inquire

- Comments related to this option to use a third-party site seemed to raise the question whether it would work as effectively as using existing USMS-branded options (feedback from a new "Volunteer Opportunities" usms.org page, or a Facebook group dedicated to USMS Volunteers).

- Will a third-party tool help with recruiting, since it may only be a web site that shares information about available volunteer roles?

- Some felt that a more active method would be training existing volunteers to recruit interested and qualified successors.

4) Any assistance that VRTF can provide for LMSC Dev Training Subcommittee?

- Per Rob C., no assistance needed at this time.

- Rob C. mentioned that the Subcommittee is still looking at the option of having a guest speaker at Convention.
