- Knowing that the Breadbasket Zone has 708,731 square miles in the Breadbasket Zone, and the Northwest Zone has 1,044,946 square miles, we discussed donating the zone jet to the larger of the two zones. MSA to donate the Breadbasket Zone Jet to the Northwest Zone.
- 3. The Zone website was discussed. The person who volunteered last year was not able to complete the task due to unforeseen reasons. There is a Facebook page that people can link to, and it has been used to a small extent. We've added an action item for Kelly Davis to look into what it would take for creating a static website.
