 Welcome – Bob Jennings – The new members to the Coaches Committee are Patrick Brennan, Lisa Dahl, Doug Fetchen, Terry Heggy, and Christine Maki. Skip Thompson (VP of Community Services) is our representative from the USMS Board. Bill Brenner and Marianne Groening will work with us from the National Office

2. Subcommittee and Task Force Reports

Awards – Bob Jennings - Chris Campbell is the chair. The committee is involved in selecting the USMS Coach of the Year and Kerry O'Brien Award recipients.

Certification. Certification Classes – Bill Brenner - Level 1, 2, & 3 and ALS certification classes will be held at the same time and location. Blended learning has been incorporated into the Level 1 classes. A coach's clinic will be held at the conclusion of the classes and the next day a stroke clinic will be held. Bob Jennings – Scott Bay will chair a subcommittee that will work with Bill creating blended learning modules as needed. One idea was what coaches could do to prepare swimmers for open water events.

Evaluation of Level 4 Applications – Bob Jennings – Scott Bay will the chair. Scott is looking for an individual outside the Coaches Committee to participate in evaluating applications. Level 4 applications will be accepted from February 15 to March 15.
