1. Officers

Although still having difficulty getting new folks to agree to run for an office we do have a good group of individuals who are keeping things going. Have had some response that a few folks may be willing to get more involved beginning in 2011. Participation at this level is an on-going issue. We continually try to encourage LMSC members to get more involved but our success rate is not very good.

Have successfully recruited a top ten replacement and interest has been voiced for an officials officer.

2. Money to Spend

We find ourselves with more money than is necessary in our bank account so have decided to spend some of it on the members. Here's what we did:

1. Waived all meet sanction fees.
2. Waived transfer fees.
3. Purchased stickers and swim caps to be sent with new registrations and renewals for 2011.
4. Offered to help host a swim meet in order to defray some costs – although there were no takers we did have more swim meets.

3. Swim Meets

Unfortunately, 2010 was not a good year for swim meets for the Nebraska LMSC. Despite loads of encouragement and offers for help, no one wanted to take the responsibility. Even the Zone meet, which we were scheduled to host, fell through at the last minute due to a scheduling conflict.

4. More Participation? (Same thoughts as last year and many previous years)

There was a lengthy discussion with a few members regarding what seems to be a lack of participation by Nebraska LMSC members in swim meets. The fact of the matter is that right now that is not what folks in this LMSC care about. Most of our members are in it for the practices and for the camaraderie and for the fun it is. For the past few years our membership has increased. This is in large part due to the fact that Todd Samland requires USMS membership for all who swim in his program. This is an extremely dedicated group of swimmers. They just do not want to go to swim meets. That may change in the future. For right now, it is better not to push them too hard.

BUT – with Long Course Nationals coming our way, the goal will be to get every adult swimmer in Nebraska to participate in at least one event.

5. Website

The Webmaster dropped the ball. Every effort is being made to get him reengaged.

6. GOALS FOR 2011

1. More swim meets – at least get a few meets “recognized” if not fully sanctioned.
2. Spend more money on members in order to make their swimming experience fun and beneficial (agree to absorb some of the costs of a swim meet, continue to waive some fees, perhaps have a social event for the entire LMSC).
3. Continue working on participation for the 2012 Olympic Trials and how the Nebraska LMSC can help.
4. Officers – this is an on-going discussion. One that will continue to be on our goals list every year. We have got to figure out a way to get new people involved in the LMSC.
5. Website – this needs to be worked on and brought up to date and maintained on a regular basis.
6. Scheduled meetings with members in attendance.
7. Submit annual minutes and financial report on time☺
