The meeting was changed to a virtual platform due to the circumstances. These changes results in some very long and drawn-out conversations and marathon meetings (we were on the meeting for about 8 hours on Sunday evening) In the end, most of the legislation was not earth shattering for our LMSC. **Treasurer:** Tim Murphy was not able to be present due to work. At the last meeting we had around \$10,000 in the bank. We have not had many expenses with the convention being held virtually, opting into the unified fee, and not having any meets in the last year. Janet indicated that she would be happy to give up some of the revenue sharing to teams if we needed the money to help host meets.

**Sanctions Chair**: Jack Zedlitz, was absent. There was no report, although we have had no sanctioned meets within the past year due to Covid.

Top Ten/Records: No report. Top Ten Chair Leo Mendoza was absent.

**Officials**: No report. This committee chair is currently vacant. Kirsten emailed Lloyd Landreth who indicated his credentials have expired. Janet indicated that we may want to pay the annual registration for the officials chair, as most people who are officials are not able to compete in the masters meets.

**Safety**: Kathy Keffer-Sharpe has nothing to report as the Safety Chair.

Webmaster: Colin Drydale is still our webmaster. He is out of state, but he is very responsive.

**Election:** Denise Smart and Maddie Sibilia rescinded their names from Secretary. Louise motioned to accept the slate as presented with Kirsten Hoffman as the new chair and Leslie Moon as the new secretary. Janet seconded the motion. The slate was accepted unanimously.

**Unfinished business**: Louise indicated that we should update our email address so that people can reach us by contact form, so we do not receive as much spam. Kirsten indicated she would reach out to Colin to get this going.

**New Business:** Kirsten covered the information regarding the Southern Zone Multi-Pool Championship with the group along with David Herrold who has been very active from the TMSC side. After discussing the idea with the group, we asked for feedback on the one day vs. two-day format, as it seems like most Arkansas responders have indicated they didn't like the two day format. There was an overwhelming response to keep our meet a one-day event. This would also reduce the cost by either only having to pay \$4K for the Jenks pool, or potentially using the Trident Aquatic Club facility for free or a reduced cost, or being able to use the Bentonville, AR facility. Kirsten indicated she would bring this information back to the zone chair Nicole Christensen.

When asked if we would like to nominate someone for the annual convention, Janet suggested that Kirsten return as the new hair. Janet motioned to approve. Louise seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Kirsten asked if we wanted to select a 2020 Masters Swimmer of the Year, or if we wanted to table that year as we had very little activity. Kirsten motioned to pass on naming a 2020 Swimmer of the Year, and resume with the award at our 2021 August meeting.

Resolutions: Louise presented a resolution to thank Kirsten for her leadership and stepping up to chair the organization, and for her commitment to swimming in the State of Oklahoma – serving both the Masters and USA Swimming communities.
