- 1. Report from the Chair—Bob Bruce. See Rules and Legislation.
- 2. Report from USMS Vice President—Chris McGiffin. Chris reported that the next BOD meeting is scheduled for Monday, June 19 and that he will have much more to report at our next meeting.
- 3. Report from USMS Open Water Compliance Officer—Bill Roach. Bob Bruce reported 45 sanctioned events, 2 pending events, and 59 certified safety directors as of this date.

1. OW Development Subcommittee (purpose to generate real, actionable ways to develop and promote open water swimming, the central purpose in the committee definition). No report. Bob will get in touch with members of subcommittee.

- 2. Open Water Guide to Operations (OWGTO)—Bob Bruce, Chair; Lynn Hazlewood, Kathy Farrell Guizar, Denise Brown. Bob has done some work on making the guide more user friendly and will discuss items in the near future.
- 3. Rules & Legislation Subcommittee—Bob Bruce, Chair, Lynn Hazelwood, Donn Livoni, others TBD.
  - 302.2.3b No.1 Starting Line: Sue Nutty moved to accept the proposal as written. 2nd: Jenny Hodges. In a discussion regarding diving and safety, it was mentioned that there have been no reported accidents in USMS events. Will Reeves make a motion to amend the height of the platform to: (1)For platforms .75 + meters or less above the water surface, the water depth shall be no less than 6 feet 2 meters for the first 5 meters of the course. 2nd: J. Wainwright This change conforms with USA Swimming standards and will help in dual sanctioned events. Sue Nutty made a motion to further amend the proposal to add the sentence: Swimmers must enter the water feet first. 2nd: B. Kolonkowski. In a roll call vote, the motion did not carry. Will Reeves moved to recommend the amended 302.2.3b #1 to the LDC for approval. 2nd: Sue Nutty
  - 302.2.3 Starting Line: Sue Nutty moved to recommend the proposal as written to the LDC for approval. 2nd: Lynn Hazelwood.
  - 302.3 Straightaway (cable) Courses. During a discussion, committee members differed significantly in their interpretations of straightaway vs. cable swims; therefore, Bob Bruce withdrew the proposal.
  - 303.9.5 Disqualification Ally Sega made a motion to recommend 303.9.5 as written to the LDC. 2nd: Jenny Hodges
  - 307.7.9 Protests Will Reeves moved to recommend the proposal as written to the LDC. 2nd: Jenny Hodges After a lengthy discussion regarding difficulties arising at events to meet the time frame for protests, Bob Bruce pulled the item and stated that it must be in parallel to 303.12.1.
  - 308.1.1 Records Joanne moved to recommend the proposal as written to the LDC for approval. 2nd: Ally Sega.
  - 308.1.2 Joanne made a motion to recommend 308.1.2 as written to LDC for approval. 2nd: Ally Sega
