There was discussion concerning the high cost of the overhead video system and whether this system would be used on a regular basis by other championship competitions. There was also discussion concerning whether it would be better to pass this proposal or to allow a one-time suspension of the rules to allow the Omaha National Championship to use the overhead video system without requiring timers for every lane. The Omaha Championship would like to use one person every two lanes to verify names and relay orders and no timers behind the blocks. This would reduce the demand for volunteers in Omaha.
