## Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 8am by Brandon Franklin, Chair of the SSLF.

- 1. Reviewed the SSLF Mission.
- 2. Discussed April Adult to Learn to Swim Month and resources available on usms.org/learntoswim; we received approximately \$450,000 worth of free media the past two years.
- 3. Entered into an affiliate agreement with the USA Swimming Foundation to promote their youth outreach and our adult outreach initiatives.
- 4. Nancy Ridout distributed an overview of the Adult Learn-to-Swim initiative offered by her Masters Swimming program.
- 5. The SSLF Board of Trustees recommended awarding 47 grants totaling \$87,000 for 2016. Grant recipients met the minimum following criteria; Non-profit or municipality and offers or willingness to offer a Masters Swimming program. Additional criteria included use of an adult based curriculum, need based, and qualitative review.
- 6. Grant partners may send one partner to an ALTS Instructor Certification class and USMS will waive the registration fee.
- 7. The grants may be used Jan 1-Dec. 31 2016.

- 1. National Office to communicate with grant partners to secure agreements prior to December 31, 2015.
- 2. Continued promotion of April Adult ALTS month.
- 3. Continued evaluation and improvements to grant criteria.
- 4. Continued development of infrastructure to administer SSLF.
